In consideration for my being permitted by INDEPENDENCE PASS FOUNDATION ("IPF"), including its officers, directors, agents and employees, to participate in a volunteer project, outing, or other activity that takes place in an outdoor environment in mountainous terrain, I agree to the following waiver and release. Certain risks are inherent in the volunteer projects and outings as well as any associated activities and cannot be eliminated or reduced. The same inherent risks that contribute to the unique character of these activities can be the cause of damage to the equipment associated with the activity, or injury, illness, paralysis or death. I understand and acknowledge that there are risks, hazards and dangers that are inherent and integral to these activities which take place in a wilderness or outdoor environment. I understand that these inherent risks, hazards and dangers include without limitation:

- (1) Risks that involve work, travel and associated activities along and accessed from Highway 82 in the Independence Pass area. These risks include without limitation hazards and dangers associated with the use and operation of chain saws, power-driven log splitters, electric power tools, hand tools, step ladders, and construction supplies, equipment and materials and the moving, relocation, and work with trees, rocks, boulders, and other outdoor materials that may be encountered through trail cleanup, restoration, and material removal work and any other activities undertaken by IPF. These risks include without limitation the risk to fingers, arms or legs being cut or severed with accompanying blood loss, injury or death; the risk of being struck by flying debris, falling trees, wood splinters or tool parts; moving or rolling boulders and the risk of injury or death from accidental contact with vehicles traveling along Highway 82.
- (2) Risks arising from high altitude, weather and unpredictable forces of nature, including without limitation, attack by large animals or predators, temperature extremes, high wind speeds and the risks associated with falling rock, falling trees, sudden and unpredictable flash floods, snowstorms, rainstorms, hailstorms and lightning strikes which can result in hypothermia, sunburn, dehydration, frostbite, injury, paralysis or death.
- (3) Risks of drowning in a stream or river, and being injured or killed, or being wet, cold and uncomfortable.
